



Share a Photo Location

Use this guide to create a template about a favorite place to make images.

- Go to dallascameraclub.org
- Click on “*Field Trips*”
- Choose “*Photographic Opportunity Inventory*”
- Scroll down to “*Photo Opportunity Templates for download*”
- Download one of the templates:
 - For Microsoft Word users: choose the first *Style #1 Template*
 - For Apple users: choose the second *Style #1 Template*
- Your download includes an example template for guidance and a blank template for you to fill in
- “Trip Name” details:
 - The master list of photo locations is organized by country, state, and city; if the photo location is not in a city, use the closest city to it
 - For large cities like Fort Worth or Dallas, put the geographic area in parentheses after the city; using Central, North, South, East or West; some examples:
 - USA_Texas_Dallas (Central)_Belo Garden
 - USA_Texas_Fort Worth (North)_Abandoned Swift Meat Plant
 - For smaller cities, just use the city name; some examples:
 - USA_Texas_Denton_The Purple Door
 - USA_Texas_Weatherford_Chandor Gardens
- Fill in the remainder of the “Trip Profile” details for each listed topic, if known; if unknown, leave it blank
- In the “Special Notes” section at the bottom, add any other information that you think might be helpful and then add one or more photos, if possible. Re-size photos to 1920 pixels wide and 1280 pixels high, if possible, include a photo taken with your cell phone since GPS data may be embedded in the photo. When you are finished, delete the example pages and email your completed template to FWCC Photo Locations Coordinator Ron Shue: starflight_2000@yahoo.com
